Call to Artists and Collectors

Flaunting Felines is a community exhibition of visual art that is inspired by the domestic cat. Felines have been artistic muses since 1600 BC. Cats have been depicted in all mediums by the Ancient Greeks, Ancient Egyptians, Chinese calligraphy artists, Leonardo Da Vinci, Albrecht Durer, Peter Paul Reubens, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Mary Cassatt, Henri De Toulouse-Lautrec, John James Audubon, Pablo Picasso, Henri Matisse, Marc Chagall, Salvador Dali, Andy Warhol, Jim Davis, Jeff Koons, and so many more artists. Join us in flaunting all things feline by exhibiting your original cat art!

Participation: Local and regional artists, collectors, and cat-enthusiasts of any age are invited to participate. Artwork made by expressive cats is also welcome.

Artwork Presentation: Artwork may be in any medium. All artwork must be gallery ready with frames, wiring, or any special hardware needed to install the piece. Pedestals are provided. Digital submissions must provide their own viewing devices. Artwork cannot exceed 6 feet in any dimension. The Art Center reserves the right to refuse any work that is not gallery ready, may be considered potentially offensive or does not appropriately fit into the theme of the exhibit. If an artist brings in more than one artwork, additional artworks may not be displayed if exhibit space is limited. Please contact Jennifer Teter if you have any questions regarding the installation of your artwork.

Opening Reception: Friday, May 4, 2018, 7 – 9 p.m. All artists are invited to say a few words about their artwork during the gallery talks starting at 7:30 p.m. 'Cat' themed music will be played. Guests will have the opportunity to create their own handmade cat masks, cat ears, and cat toys at no cost during the opening reception. If you would like to volunteer to help with these hands-on activities, please contact Jennifer Teter. The Humane Society of Quincy will also be present. This opening coincides with the reception for the Atmospheric Paintings by Victoria Lowe and Framed Fidos exhibits.
