If your proposal is approved class time slots are assigned on a first come first serve basis. When a proposal is approved the QAC will begin the marketing process. Art Camp Instructor positions pay \$20 per hour which includes ½ hour prep and ½ hour clean up due to the compact nature of the schedule. Paychecks are dispersed every other week.

ART SUPPLIES & CLASS BUDGET

Art Supplies: We try to keep our registration fees for children very affordable at \$7 per class hour. Children's art supplies are stored in our education supply closet and throughout the studio. It is advised that you visit the art supplies available before requesting the order of additional supplies. We supply general art supplies such as paper, glue, scissors, fabric, yarn, clay, glaze, brushes, water-based paints, printmaking supplies and much more.

Class Budget: This year we need to purchase as little as possible for two reasons; to stay within our fiscal budget and to use as much of the over abundant supplies already on hand. Please visit and 'shop' the storage of art supplies to plan your class projects to help us use as much as possible already in house. You may request a special purchase but do so as soon as possible so that your request can be considered.

Snack & Activity Time: Each class time should incorporate a 15 - 20 minute snack & activity time. During appropriate weather we encourage our instructors to take the children outside into the park out front. Snacks are stored in a bin in the studio. Outside toys are available. Instructors are in charge of the Snack & Activity Time each day.

Class Enhancement: Special consideration will be given to proposals that incorporate class activities in our two art galleries, field trips, special visitors, art history, cross-curricular, and innovative themes.

Student Gallery: Instructors are encouraged to display their student artwork during the class week and to invite parents to a reception during the last 15 minutes of the last class meeting. Please request special snacks and help from the Director of Education.
