45th Annual High School Student Art Competition

Eligibility Students grades 9-12 from schools within a fifty-mile radius of Quincy, Illinois are eligible. Works will be judged for inclusion in the exhibit, and those accepted for display must meet the following criteria:

Entries Students may enter up to 3 works for \$10. All mediums are eligible. All artwork must be original. No copies of copyrighted imagery are allowed. All two-dimensional artwork should be suitably framed, and ready for exhibition with a secure wire fastened to the back. Do not use tape to secure hanging wire! Sawtooth or plate hangers are not preferred. No damaged mats. Three-dimensional and two-dimensional artwork cannot be over 6 feet in any one direction. Artwork requiring a digital presentation must come with its own viewing device. The following materials used to create hanging devices will not be accepted: Packing tape, scotch tape, epoxy/glue, string/yarn, and pipe cleaners.

Awards All awards will be presented at the discretion of the judge. Criteria for awards include originality and quality of artwork.
