What is Beaux Arts?

- It is a fundraiser for the Quincy Art Center and goes to support all the exhibitions and educational programs for Quincy and the surrounding area.
- It is a Quincy tradition! The first ball took place in 1930 and was a way for young women to be presented to the community and support the arts.
- The Ball! The annual ball takes place in December and marks the end of the year long fundraising and volunteer efforts by the Queen candidates. This formal event includes men wearing ties, women in gorgeous dresses, and after the coronation, a dance party. Good times are had by all!

Why should I participate?

- Beaux Arts is open to young women who are freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior high school students. Work on skills to help make a difference in your community by being a volunteer! Volunteer opportunities at the Art Center include: assisting with children's classes, after school programs, outreach projects, Q-Fest, ArtFest!, exhibitions, and office.
- Volunteering helps to develop professional relationships, new skills, and build your resume.
- Meet other area high schoolers who are making an impact in their community through entrepreneurial and volunteer leadership!



What do the candidates do?

- Seniors are responsible for ticket sales and acquiring sponsorships for the Beaux Arts Ball. This can begin as early as a year before the event. The Queen candidate with the largest funds raised through ticket sales and sponsorships will be crowned Beaux Arts Queen during the ball.
- Freshman, Sophomore, and Junior candidates are responsible for duties before and during the night of the ball.
- All candidates, freshman through senior, are eligible to acquire volunteer hours. During the ball, a senior will be named Young Women of Achievement who has volunteered the most hours at the Art Center.
