This is a chance to creatively capture what makes Adams County unique and special as we celebrate two centuries of community and culture. Submission Guidelines:

- Design Elements:
 - The logo should be bold, clear, and scalable (works well both large and small).
 - Use colors, shapes, and symbols that represent Adams County's history, present, or future.
 - The design must be original and created by the submitter.
 - Keep it simple! The logo should be easily recognizable and versatile for various uses, including merchandise, promotional materials, and digital platforms.
- Format:
 - Submit your design in a high-resolution digital format (JPG, PNG, or PDF).
 - Ensure your design is no larger than 5 MB in size.
 - Please include a short description (100 words max) explaining the inspiration behind your design.

All entries must be submitted by **August 1, 2025**.

Judging Criteria:

Your logo will be judged based on the following:

- Creativity & Originality
- Connection to the theme: Icons of Adams County
- Simplicity & Scalability
- Overall Visual Impact
